### SUMMARY

24.8% of the total no. of houses in the city were totally destroyed by Typhoon Reming. Barangays which was heavily devastated (more than 50% of houses totally destroyed) are the ffg:

- a. Nino Jesus - 59.6%
- b. San Vicente Norte - 59.5%
- c. Antipolo - 56.5%
- d. Salvacion - 54.6%

An estimated 5,000 families were displaced by the typhoon mostly located in the mountain barangays.

2. Medicines for coughs & cold, fever, antibiotics, Diarrhea, etc
